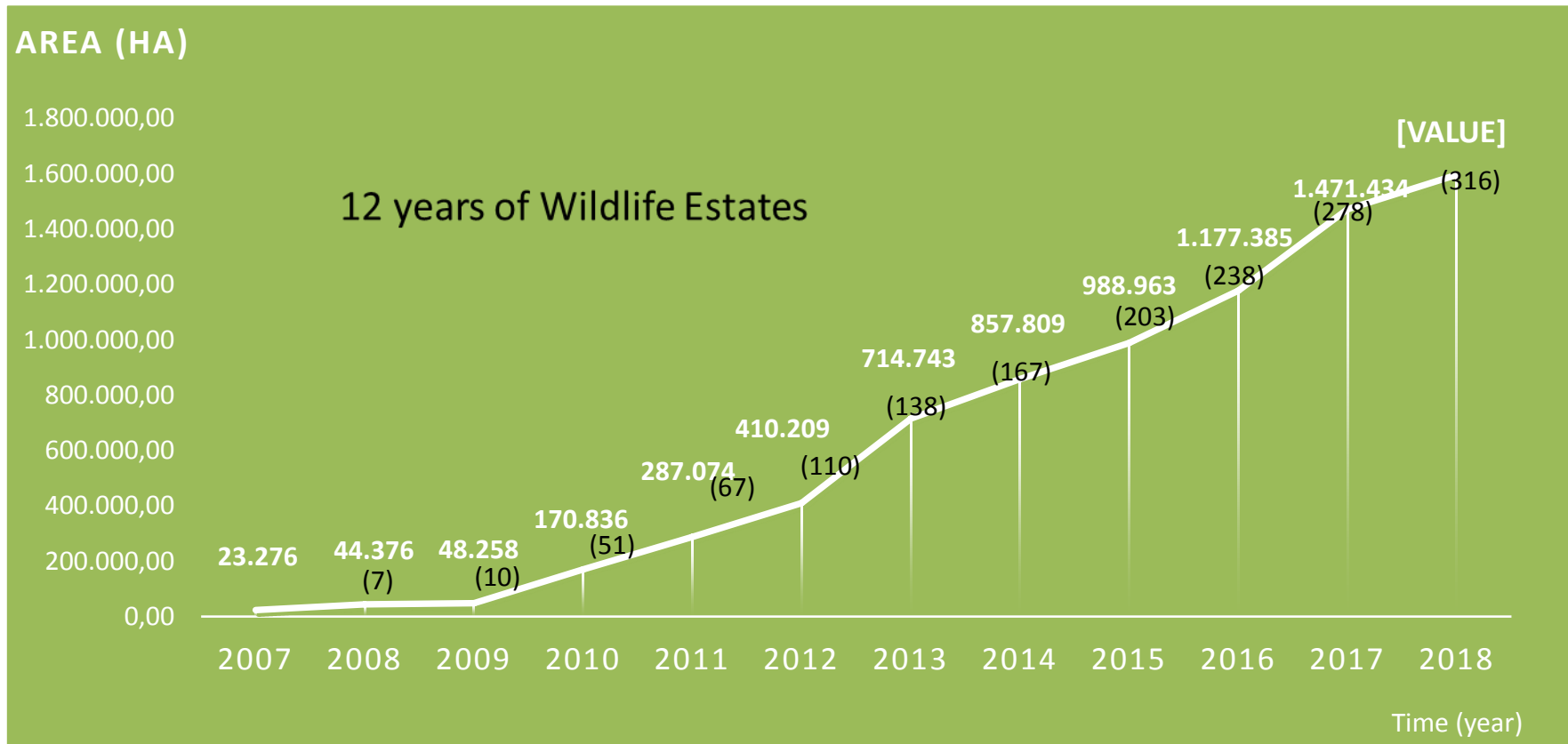

- Average annual growth rate 2014 - 2017: 19,8%

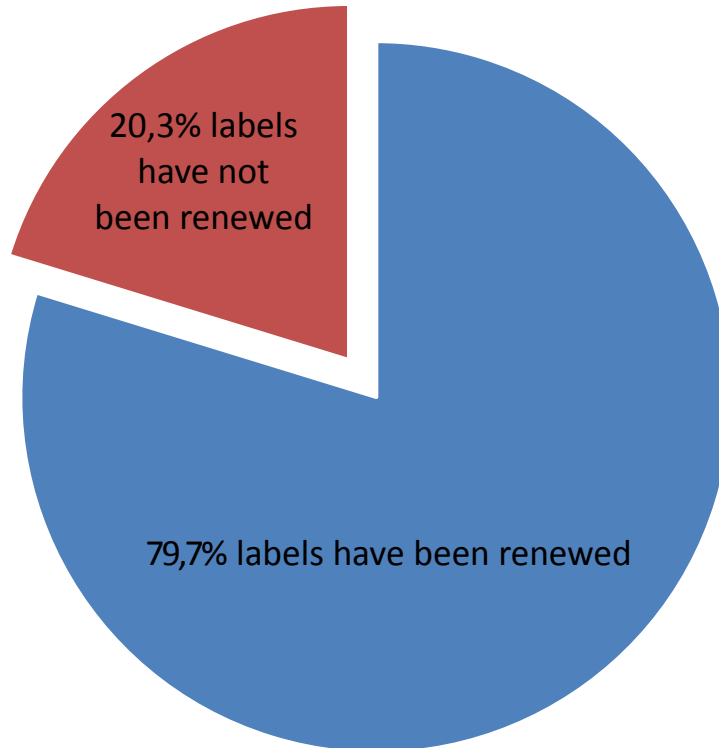

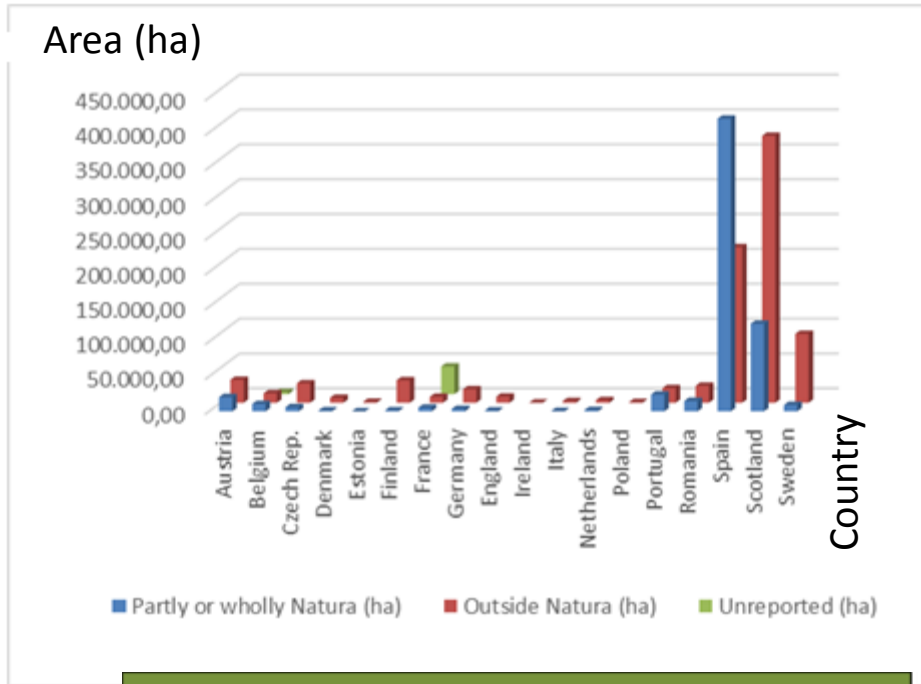
Expired labels

Status in August 2018

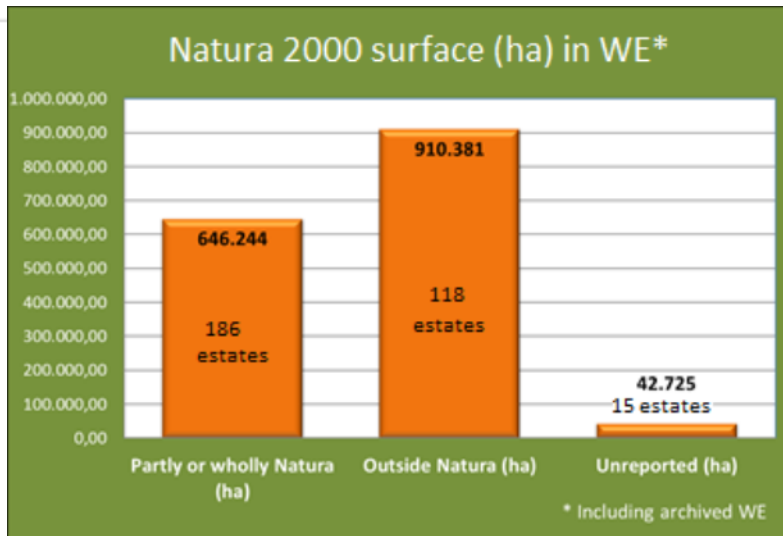
- * Reasons for non-renewal include change of management or sale of land



✿ The area of WE being partly or wholly Natura 2000 reaches 40,4% of the total WE area

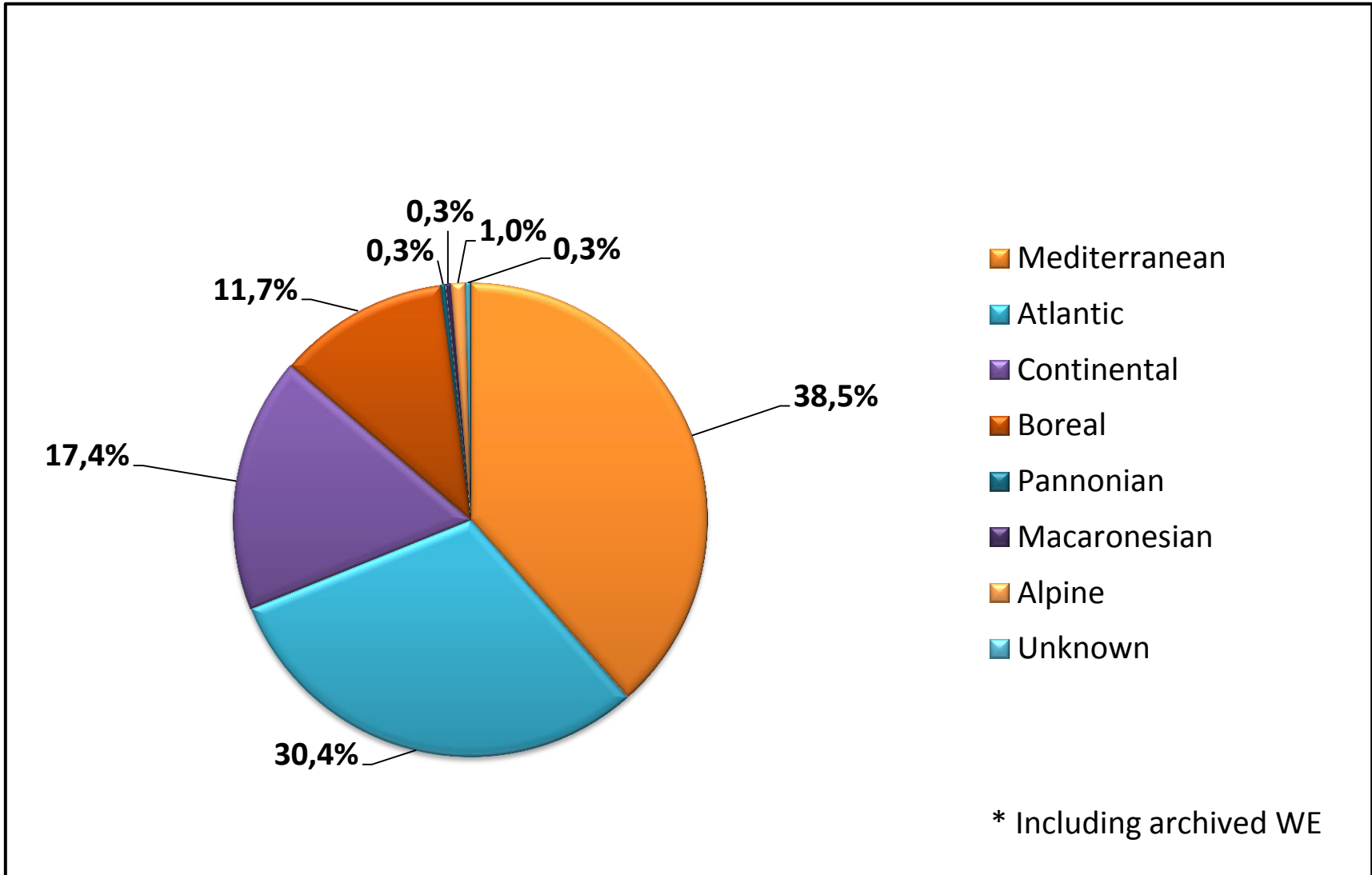
✿ 20,1% of the WE are wholly Natura 2000

✿ 58,3 % of the WE are wholly or partly Natura 2000



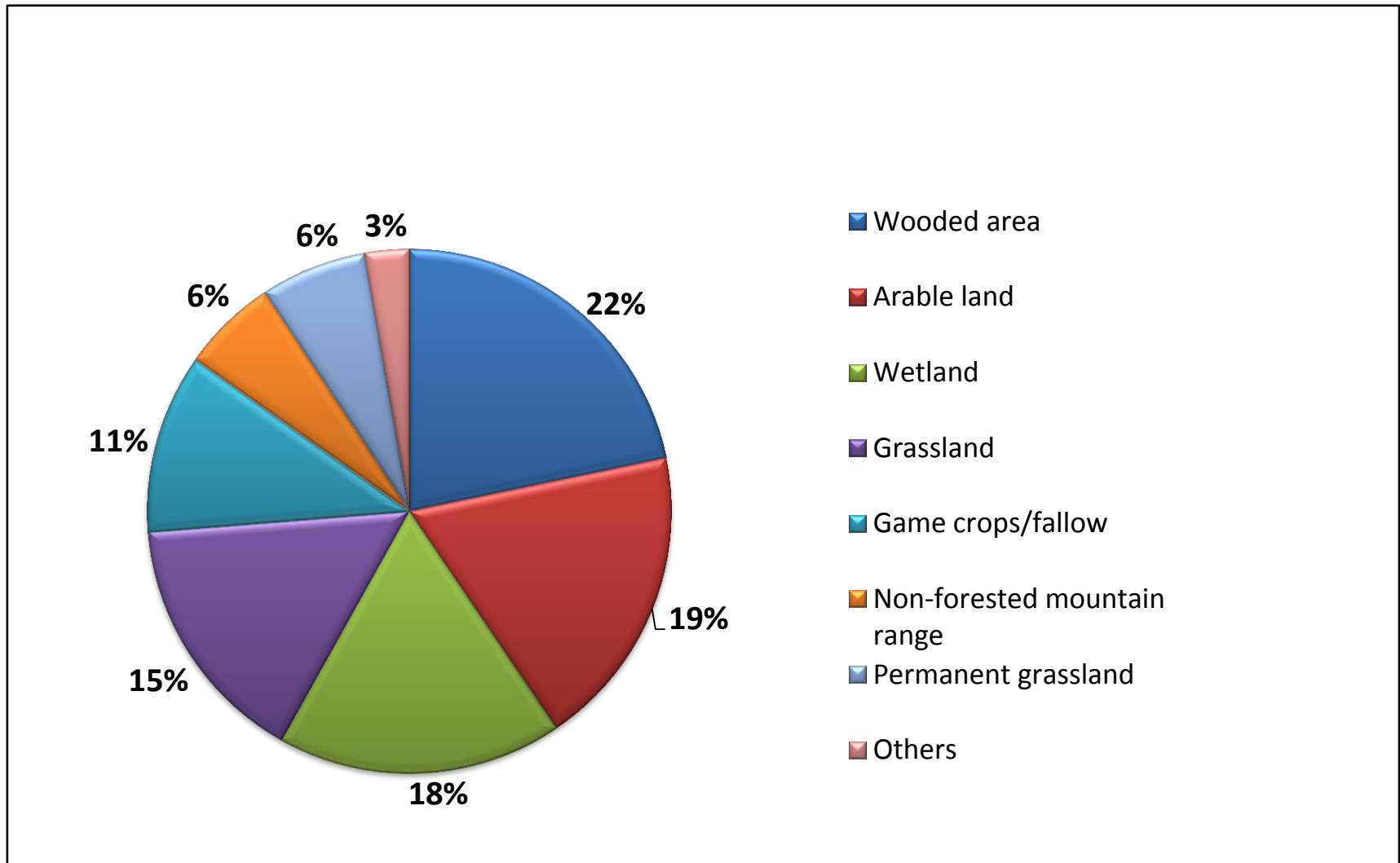
